

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes  
Monday, September 16, 2019 – 6:30 pm  
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:33 pm. Mayor established there was a quorum present. All city council members were present. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Steve Honeycutt gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Girl Scout Troop 34006.

Budget Workshop was called at 6:34 pm and adjourned at 6:36pm.

Regular meeting was called to order at 6:37 pm.

During public comment time Girl Scouts Troop 34006 presented the city council a poster showing the badges they had accomplished. Cory Phillips told the council that he has purchased property on S 6<sup>th</sup> St and plans to erect a fence at 704 W 6<sup>th</sup> St. A survey has been completed and he will begin fencing his property which will require a fence to be moved that Carolyn Strong put up. Carol and John Brooks told the city council they were present to support Mr. Phillips. Carolyn Strong asked the council if the city put the blue marker in the middle of the street and what is it there for.

Public hearing was held on the proposed budget for 2019-2020. There were no public comments.

Councilman Westbrook made the motion to approve the city council meeting minutes of August 19, 2019 and also approve the September 2019 financial report. Councilman Paniagua seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

A Public Hearing was held on the proposed 2019 Property Tax Rate for the City of Milano. There were no public comments made.

Councilman Paniagua made the motion to adopt the proposed 2019-2020 Budget by Ordinance #2019-01. Councilman Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Westbrook made the motion to ratify the ad valorem property tax revenue increase reflected in the adopted 2019-2020 budget. Councilman Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Paniagua made the motion to adopt the tax rate at \$.25 per hundred which will raise the property tax by \$410.00 by Ordinance #2019-02. Councilman Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Lenz made the motion to approve the Manufactured Home Permit submitted by Alfonso Reyes. Councilman Westbrook seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Paniagua made the motion to rekey the civic center door locks. Griffin Locksmith from Bryan will do the work. Councilman Westbrook seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Lenz made the motion to approve the Girl Scouts to meet twice a month at the civic center with no charge. Councilman Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:13 pm.
