

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes  
Monday, August 17, 2020 – 6:30 pm  
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Mayor established there was a quorum present. Councilman Edward Lenz was absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Mayor Westbrook gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.

Councilman Steve Honeycutt made the motion to approve the city council meeting minutes of June 15, 2020 and the called city council meeting minutes of July 27, 2020 and approve the financial report dated June 16, 2020 through August 17, 2020. There was no city council meeting on July 20, 2020 due to COVID-19. Councilman John Paniagua seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor/Judge Karl Westbrook administered the Oath of Office to John Paniagua to serve the term he was reelected to in May, 2020.

Council heard a proposal from Ethan Ford with WISE (Wireless Internet Service Provider) Wireless. Mr. Ford proposes to build a communication tower on city property to provide wireless internet services to the area. Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to postpone this proposal until the August 25, 2020 meeting to allow time to research some questions about the proposal. Councilman Steve Honeycutt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Karl Westbrook appointed a committee to research and provide a list of the needed street signs. Heading up the committee is Councilman Edward Lenz. Councilman Glenda Westbrook and Councilman Bryan Woods will also serve on the committee. This committee will report back to the council with a recommendation for the signs that need to be purchased.

The council reviewed the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Another workshop will be held to finalize the proposed changes for the new budget. A budget hearing will be held at the September 21, 2020 city council meeting.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:31 pm.
