

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes  
Tuesday, January 19, 2021 – 6:30 pm  
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Mayor established there was a quorum present. Councilman Steve Honeycutt were absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Mayor Westbrook gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no comments during the public hearing regarding the submission of an application to the Texas Department of Agriculture for a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program (TxCDBG) grant. The purpose of the hearing was to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the citizen participation plan, the development of local housing and community development needs, the amount of TXCDBG funding available, all eligible TXCDBG activities, and the use of past TxCDBG funds.

Ben Graham spoke during the public comments time. He asked the city council to sell him the portion of the alley in Block 16 that joins the property he owns, Lots 11-13 in Block 16 of Milano Junction. Mayor Westbrook responded by saying that should the alley ever be considered for sale that he would be notified immediately.

Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to approve the city council meeting minutes, with amendments, for December 21, 2020 and approve the financial report for January, 2021. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Glenda Westbrook made the motion to approve the re-plat of Lots 1 through 10 and Lots 14 through 20 and the abandonment of the alley between Lots 1 through 10 and Lots 14 through 20 of Block 16 of Milano Junction with the stipulation that if the sale of the property between William N. Graham and Dollar General fails then the alley will be retained by the city. Councilman John Paniagua seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to Order the General Election for May 1, 2021. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Edward Lenz made the motion to authorize a joint election with Milano ISD for the May 1, 2021 General Election. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.


Councilman Bryan Woods made the motion to authorize a contract with Kevin Terry for election technical services for the May 1, 2021 General Election. Councilman John Paniagua seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman Edward Lenz made the motion to approve a proposal for audit services for the city for the year ending September 30, 2020 and subsequent years from Michele Kohring Kwiatkowski, CPA partner with Seidel Schroeder, Brenham, Texas. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:26 pm.
