

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, May 17, 2021 – 6:30 pm
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Mayor established there was a quorum with all council members being present. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Milam County Pct. 3 Judge Andy Isaacs gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no comments during the public comment time.

Councilman Bryan Woods made the motion to approve the city council meeting minutes for the April 19, 2021 city council meeting with corrections (the first word on the third paragraph was changed from Councilwoman to Councilman), approve the financial report for May, 2021 and pay the bills for the City of Milano. Councilwoman Glenda Westbrook seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Milam County Pct. 3 Judge Andy Isaacs swore in Mayor Karl Westbrook. Mayor Westbrook is serving his second term.


Mayor Karl Westbrook swore in Councilman Steve Honeycutt, Councilman Bryan Woods and Councilwoman Glenda Westbrook. Their term will be for two years.

Council gathered information about flooring for the civic center. After discussion, Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to accept the bid from Wilson Tile and Stone for \$17,930.75 to install ceramic tile in the civic center. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The July 4th Parade and Community Wide Hot Dog lunch will be held on July 3rd. Parade will begin at 10:30 from the football field parking lot. The Community Wide Hot Dog lunch will be served in the civic center immediately following the parade.


Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to do Cybersecurity Training on an individual basis. The training is required to be completed by June 14 and to report compliance with the training requirement to the Department of Information Resources (DIR) by June 15, 2021. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:02 pm.
