

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, November 15, 2021 – 6:30 pm
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. Mayor established there was a quorum present. Councilman Steve Honeycutt was absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Mayor Westbrook gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

During public comments, Jesse Love reported a tree tangled with an electricity pole is in danger falling. Mayor Westbrook said he would go look at the tree and decide what action to take.

Councilman Bryan Woods made the motion to approve the regular city council meeting minutes of September 20, 2021 and the called city council meeting minutes of September 27, 2021 noting that there was no meeting in October of 2021 and approve the financial report for November, 2021 and pay the bills for City of Milano. Councilman John Paniagua seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. During this time Councilwoman asked to see all documentation pertaining to TMRS from 2013 to present. This information will be available at the next regular city council meeting on December 20, 2021.

After discussion, Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to approve the bank depository letters and the legal notice to be published in the newspaper noting that the date be changed to five years for the time frame. i.e., "Proposal will be for the period from the date of award on December 20, 2021 through November 30, 2026." Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to sign Ordinance 2022-01 to designate The Cameron Herald as the official newspaper for the City of Milano. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion, Councilman Paniagua made the motion adopt a capitalization policy for the City of Milano effective November 15, 2021. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:13 pm.
