

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, May 16, 2022 – 6:30 pm
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm. Mayor Westbrook established there was a quorum present. Councilwoman Glenda Westbrook and Councilman Steve Honeycutt were absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Mayor Westbrook gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.

Councilman Edward Lenz made the motion to approve the regular city council meeting minutes of March 21, 2022 and approve the financial report for May, 2022 and pay the bills for City of Milano, noting that the city council meeting of April 18, 2022 was canceled. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Westbrook swore in Councilman Edward Lenz and Councilman John Paniagua to serve two-year terms.

After discussion, Councilman Bryan Woods made the motion to appoint Councilman John Paniagua to serve as Mayor Pro-Tem for one year. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion, Councilman John Paniagua made the motion to have the 4th of July parade and Community Wide Hot Dog Lunch on Monday, July 4th. Parade will begin at 10:30 am from the football field and the hot dog lunch will be served immediately following the parade. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion, Councilman Edward Lenz made the motion to contact the city attorney regarding a letter received from Carolyn Strong and seek advice on how to proceed. Councilman John Paniagua seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Westbrook presented correspondence from FVF Law Firm and from City Attorney Barbara Boulware-Wells to the council regarding legal action involving the City of Milano Volunteer Fire Department and a vehicle accident involving a fireman. No action was taken.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 6:51 pm.
