

City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes
Monday, October 17, 2022 – 6:30 pm
Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Pro-Tem John Paniagua called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and established there was a quorum present. Mayor Karl Westbrook and Councilwoman Glenda Westbrook were absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Pro-Tem Paniagua. The invocation was given by Councilman Chad Lagrone and the Pledge of Allegiance were led by Mayor Pro-Tem Paniagua.

During public comment time Jesse Love approached the council about the maintenance on East Avenue D. He expressed his concerns and advised the repairs to East Avenue D were long overdue. There is overgrowth and the street needs to be moved back to its original place. AMR Ambulance Services had great difficulty loading a patient at a residence on East Avenue D. Mayor Pro-Tem Paniagua stated that it would be put on the agenda soon.

Councilman Chad Lagrone made the motion to approve the city council meeting minutes of September 19, 2022 and approve the called city council meeting minutes of September 26, 2022 meeting. and pay the bills for City of Milano. Councilman Bryan Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro-Tem Paniagua opened the sealed bids for the sale of the office building and storage building. After discussion, Councilman Bryan Woods made the motion to accept the highest bid for the buildings. John Pat Yakesch was the highest bidder on each building. Councilman Edward Lenz seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
