## City of Milano City Council Meeting Minutes Monday, April 17, 2023 – 6:30 pm Milano Civic Center 120 West Avenue E Milano, TX 76556

Mayor Westbrook called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and established there was a quorum present. Councilman Bryan Woods was absent. The meeting opened with greetings from Mayor Westbrook. Councilman Chad Lagrone gave the invocation and Mayor Westbrook led the Pledge of Allegiance.
